Grades 3rd, 4th, 5th - language arts, mathematics, science, social studies

Testing Window: April 21st-May 1st, 2015

Comprehensive

- single program, not series of tests (replaces CRCT; EOCT; WA)

Consolidated

- combine reading, language arts, and writing into a single measure to align to the standards

Blended: Criterion-Referenced and Norm-Referenced

- criterion-referenced performance information in the form of four performance levels
- norm-referenced performance information in the form of national percentiles

General Test Parameters

- ELA- 3 sections, 1 of which focus mainly on writing
- Math- 2 sections
- Science- 2 sections (all selected response questions)
- Social Studies- 2 sections (all selected response questions)

Types of Items

- Selected Response (aka, multiple-choice)
 - o all content areas
 - o evidence-based selected response in ELA
- Constructed-Response
 - o ELA and mathematics
- Extended-Response
 - o ELA and mathematics
- Technology Enhanced
 - o to begin in 2016-2017
